ABOUT FESTIVAL 24

Festival 24 is an event organised by Sport dans la Ville

Over 10 days, from July 19 to 28, 2024, 500 young people from all over the world gathered in Lyon and Paris to celebrate the values of sport and Olympism.

This international solidarity Festival aimed to offer young participants a unique and transformative international experience just before the opening ceremony of the Paris 2024 Olympic Games.

As part of the #Legacy project of Paris 2024, the Festival 24 continued this desire for transmission, sharing, and encounters around the values of sport, contributing, as the Olympic movement emphasizes:

'building a peaceful and better world by educating youth through sport practiced without discrimination of any kind and in the Olympic spirit, which requires mutual understanding with a spirit of friendship, solidarity and fair play.'




IN LYON








Culture and art also unite people, as the participants were able to experience on this day by dancing, singing, and graffitiing, all in unison, regardless of their language, origin, or gender...

THURSDAY, JULY 25 SPORT FOR SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT SUMMIT

July 25 was also marked by a major event in Paris: the first international summit dedicated to mobilising the world of sport to invest in future generations, *#Sport4SD*.

Thanks to our partner AFD (Agence Française du Développement), 4 young participants from Nepal, Australia and Ukraine represented international youth at this event organised at the initiative of the President of the French Republic, Emmanuel Macron, and the President of the International Olympic Committee, Thomas Bach.



Basmala Kaibi, a young beneficiary of the Association, spoke to all the heads of state invited to the summit. Her speech highlighted the impact of sport on her life. During the Festival 24, Basmala was a Young Leader, passing on the values of Sport dans la Ville.

The summit brought together 500 participants: heads of state and government, heads of international organisations, athletes and representatives of the sporting movement (French and international federations, the Olympic movement, associations and entrepreneurs) and important players in the financing of sport and development. The Paris Agreement on Sport and Sustainable Development was signed at the event.

MONTPARNASSE TOWER AND OPENING CEREMONY OF THE OLYMPIC GAMES


The long-awaited moment of Festival 24: the day of the opening ceremony of the Paris 2024 Olympic Games!





MEASURING THE SOCIAL IMPACT OF FESTIVAL 24

For ten days, Festival 24 brought together young people from all over the world, who are often excluded from mobility, offering them a unique experience of the Olympic and Paralympic Games. Festival 24 aims to have an impact on its participants (Young Participants, Young Leaders and Delegation Leaders). To measure this social impact, Sport dans la Ville called on KOREIS, an independent consultancy firm specialized in social impact assessment.

What were the main steps of this social impact study?



During the 10 days of the Festival, the camera follows various participants from = around the world. Destinies intersect over these 10 days, with shared emotions, learning and discoveries that will leave a lasting mark on each of these young people. Back home, what memories did they keep?

What moments will have left the biggest impression on them and, above all, what projects, dreams and desires will the Festival have brought out in these young people?

A film about the life stories of several young people, meeting at this unique event that brought them together over these ten days.
